RESOLUTION No. 51-2023

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF CROOKSVILLE REQUESTING THE PERRY COUNTY AUDITOR TO CERTIFY TO THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF CROOKSVILLE THE TOTAL CURRENT VALUATION OF THE VILLAGE OF CROOKSVILLE AND THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF REVENUE THAT WILL BE GENERATED BY A RENEWAL TAX OF 4 TENTHS MILLS LEVIED FOR THE MUNICIPAL PARK AND SWIMMING POOL FOR THE VILLAGE OF CROOKSVILLE, IN EXCESS OF THE 10 MILL LIMITATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

A majority of the members of the Council of the Village of Crooksville, Perry County, Ohio, concurring therein, **BE IT, THEREFORE, RESOLVED:**

WHEREAS, the Village Council, which is the Taxing Authority of the Village of Crooksville, finds the taxes that may be raised within the Ten (10) Mill limit will be insufficient to provide for the necessary requirements of the Village, and that it is necessary to levy a **RENEWAL** tax of Four Tenths (0.4) Mills, in excess of that limitation, at the general election to be held on Tuesday, November 7, 2023, for operation of The Municipal Park and Swimming Pool of the Village, pursuant to Section 5705.19 (H) of the Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council, acting pursuant to Ohio law, hereby requests the Perry County Auditor to certify certain information to the Village Fiscal Officer in connection with the proposed **RENEWAL** tax of Four Tenths (0.4) Mills for operation of The Municipal Park and Swimming Pool of the Village of Crooksville.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE OF CROOKSVILLE, PERRY COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Perry County Auditor is hereby requested to certify to the Village Fiscal Officer the total current tax valuation of the Village of Crooksville, and the dollar amount of revenue that will be generated by a **RENEWAL** tax levied in the Village of Crooksville in the amount of Four Tenths (0.4) Mills for a period of Five (5) Years for operation of The Municipal Park and Swimming Pool of the Village, in accordance with Section 5705.19 (H) of the Revised Code.

Section 2: It is requested that such certification be issued by the Perry County Auditor to the Village of Crooksville within ten (10) days after the auditor's receipt of this resolution, in accordance with Ohio law.

Section 3: The proposed levy is a **RENEWAL** levy for Four Tenths (0.4) Mills for the purposes set forth in Section 5705.19 (H) of the Ohio Revised Code and specifically for operation of The Municipal Park and Swimming Pool for the Village.

Section 4: The amount of the **RENEWAL** levy is Four Tenths (0.4) Mills, to be levied for a period of five (5) years. The **RENEWAL** tax shall be voted on at the General Election to be held Tuesday, November 7, 2023, and the levy shall be upon the duplicate beginning for Tax Year 2024, and first collected in Tax Year 2025.

Section 5: The Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to certify this Resolution to the Perry County Auditor.

Section 6: This Resolution is hereby declared an **EMERGENCY MEASURE** necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of the Village of Crooksville in the County of Perry.


THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT AT THE EARLIEST TIME PROVIDED BY THE LAW OF THE STATE OF OHIO.

The county auditor of Perry County, Ohio, does hereby certify the following:

- On June 5, 2023, the taxing authority of the Village of Crooksville (political subdivision name) certified a copy of its resolution or ordinance adopted June 5, 2023, requesting the county auditor to certify the current taxable value of the subdivision and the amount of revenue that would be produced by () mills, to levy a tax outside the 10-mill limitation for Park & Pool purposes pursuant to Revised Code § 5705.19 (H), to be placed on the ballot at the November 7, 2023, election. The levy type is Renewal.
- The property tax revenue that will be produced by the stated millage, assuming the taxable value of the subdivision remains constant throughout the life of the levy, is calculated to be \$ 9,000.00.
- The total taxable value of the subdivision used in calculating the estimated property tax revenue is \$ 29,024,640.00.
- The millage for the requested levy is (0.400) mills per \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$ 14.00 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value.

Instructions

- "Total taxable value" includes the taxable value of all real property in the subdivision as indicated on the tax list most recently certified for collection and estimates of the taxable value of public utility personal property for the first year the levy will be collected as set forth on the worksheets prescribed in conjunction with this form. If the subdivision is located in more than one county, the home county auditor (where the greatest taxable value of the subdivision is located) shall obtain the assistance of the other county auditors to establish the total tax valuation of the subdivision.
- For purposes of this certification, "subdivision" includes any agency, board, commission or other authority authorized to request a taxing authority to submit a tax levy on its behalf. See R.C. 5705.01(A) & (C).
- "Levy type" includes the following: (1) additional, (2) renewal, (3) renewal with an increase, (4) renewal with a decrease, (5) replacement, (6) replacement with an increase and (7) replacement with a decrease levies.
- In completing Lines 1 and 4 of this form, mills should be identified in whole numbers, i.e., 5 mills, rather than as a fraction of a dollar, i.e., \$0.005. This expression is consistent with the prior practice of identifying mills in whole numbers per \$1 of valuation.
- "The county auditor's appraised value" means the true value in money of real property. R.C. 5705.01(P).
- For any levy or portion of a levy, an estimate of the levy's annual collections, rounded to the nearest one thousand dollars, which shall be calculated assuming that the amount of the tax list of the taxing authority remains throughout the life of the levy the same as the amount of the tax list for the current year, and if this is not determined, the estimated amount submitted by the auditor to the county budget commission. R.C. 5705.03(B).
- Please file this certificate with the subdivision as soon as possible, so the taxing authority can pass a resolution to proceed not later than 90 days before the election.

CALCULATING PROPERTY TAX OF A PROPOSED LEVY

ASK FOR YOUR ASSESSED VALUATION. THIS SHOULD BE 35% OF THE CURRENT APPRAISED VALUATION OF HOME PLUS LAND. THE APPRAISED VALUATION MAY OR MAY NOT REFLECT ACTUAL MARKET VALUE. PROPERTY TAXES ARE BASED ON THE ASSESSED VALUATION.

MULTIPLY THE LEVY MILLAGE BY .001. E.G., IF THE LEVY IS 4.2 MILLS, THE RESULT IS .0042

MULTIPLY THIS NUMBER TIMES THE ASSESSED VALUATION. THE RESULT WILL BE THE MAXIMUM NEW TAX YOU WOULD PAY.

THE STATE CURRENTLY PAYS 10% OF PROPERTY TAXES PLUS AN ADDITIONAL 2.5% FOR OWNER-OCCUPIED PROPERTIES. SO MULTIPLY YOUR ANSWER FROM STEP 3 BY .875 (87.5%) TO GET THE ACTUAL NEW TAX.

EXAMPLE: APPRAISED VALUATION \$128,000

ASSESSED VALUATION \$44,800

4.2 MIL LEVY

$\$44,800 \times .0042 = \188.16

$\$188.16 \times .875 = \164.64 THIS IS THE ADDITIONAL TAX FOR THE NEW LEVY

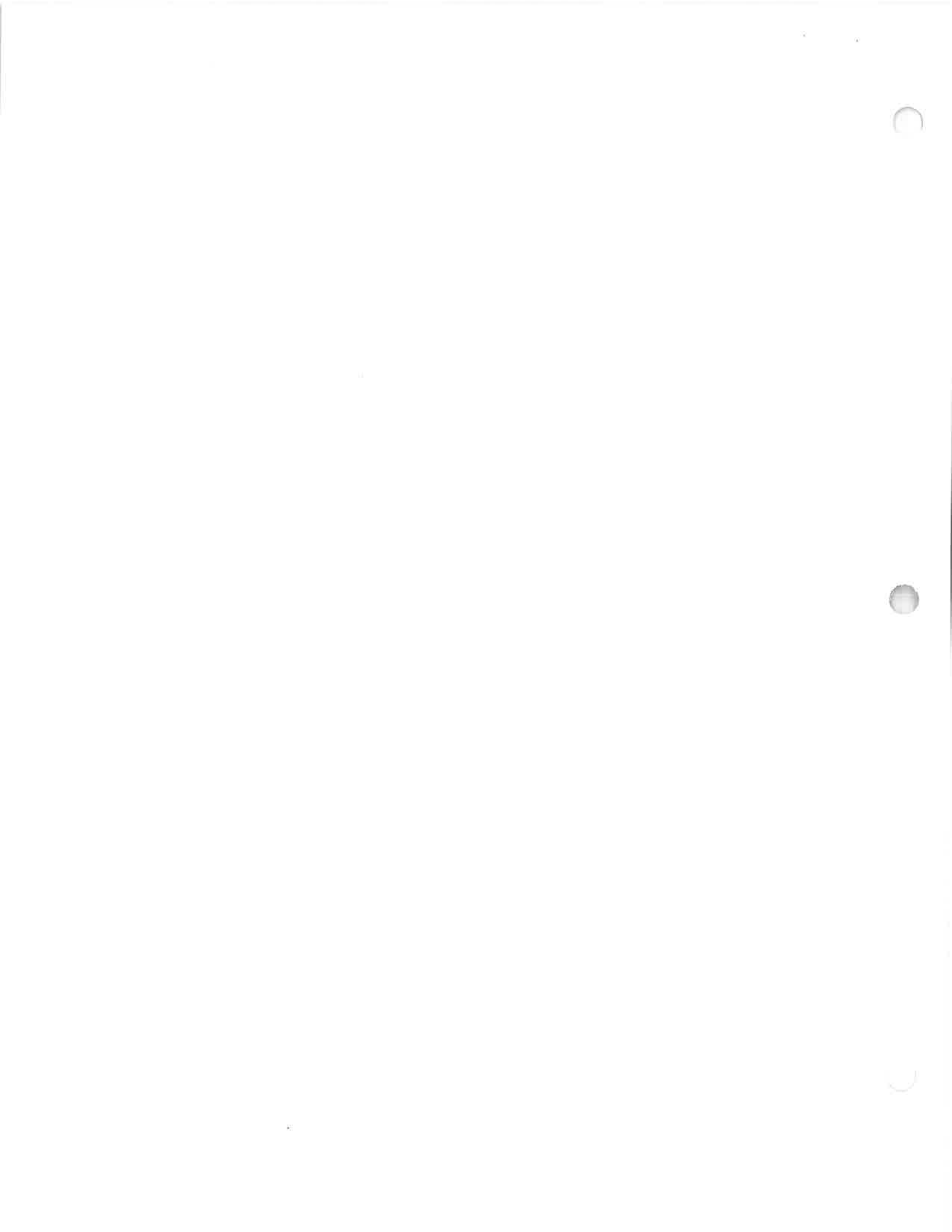
