RESOLUTION No. 54-2023

RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE 10 MILL LIMITATION REVISED CODE, SEC. 5705.19, .191, .26

The Village Council of Crooksville met in Regular Session on the 17th day of July, 2023 at the Council Chambers with the following members present:

Mr. Redfern moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the Ten (10) Mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Village of Crooksville, in the County of Perry;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 51-2023, passed June 5, 2023, by the Council of the Village of Crooksville, the County Auditor has certified to the Village of Crooksville the total current tax valuation of the Village of Crooksville in the amount of \$29,024,640.00, and has certified the estimated tax revenue that will be produced by a tax levied in the amount of Four Tenths (0.4) Mills on the taxable property within the Village and for the operation of The Municipal Park and Swimming Pool, in the amount of \$9,000.00.

NOW THEREFORE,

A majority of the members of the Council of the Village of Crooksville, Perry County, Ohio, concurring therein, **BE IT, THEREFORE, RESOLVED**:

Section 1: That the amount of taxes within the ten (10) mill limitation (Section 5705.02 O.R.C.), on the taxable property within the Village will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said Village.

Section 2: That it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the Ten (10) Mill limitation for the benefit of the Village of Crooksville (Section 5705.02 and Article 12, Section 2, Ohio Constitution), for the purpose of providing funds for operation of The Municipal Park and Swimming Pool, the Ohio Revised Code Number for said purpose being 5709.19 (H); that the County Auditor estimates the tax levy will collect \$9,000.00 annually, at a rate not exceeding Four Tenths (0.4) Mills for each dollar (\$1.00) of the taxable value, which amounts to Fourteen Dollars (\$14.00) for each One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) of the County Auditor's appraised value, for a period of Five (5) Years, commencing in 2024, first due in calendar year 2025.

Section 3: That this is a RENEWAL levy of an existing tax and shall be submitted to

the electors at the next General Election held on Tuesday, November 7, 2023.

Section 4: That said levy shall be placed upon the tax list of the current year after the February settlement next succeeding the election, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof, and collected beginning with the 2024 tax duplicate pertaining to the Village of Crooksville.

Section 5: That the Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Director of Elections, Perry County, Ohio, in order that suitable arrangements can be made for the submission of said question of levying taxes to the electors of the Village of Crooksville at the General Election to be held at the usual places within said Village on the 7th Day of November, 2023.

That the Fiscal Officer of the Village of Crooksville, County of Perry, Ohio, **Section 6:** shall request the Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.

CALCULATING PROPERTY TAX OF A PROPOSED LEVY

ASK FOR YOUR ASSESSED VALUATION. THIS SHOULD BE 35% OF THE CURRENT APPRAISED VALUATION OF HOME PLUS LAND. THE APPRAISED VALUATION MAY OR MAY NOT REFLECT ACTUAL MARKET VALUE. PROPERTY TAXES ARE BASED ON THE ASSESSED VALUATION.

MULTIPLY THE LEVY MILLAGE BY .001. E.G., IF THE LEVY IS 4.2 MILLS, THE RESULT IS .0042

MULTIPLY THIS NUMBER TIMES THE ASSESSED VALUATION. THE RESULT WILL BE THE MAXIMUM NEW TAX YOU WOULD PAY.

The state currently pays 10% of property taxes plus an additional 2.5% for owner-occupied properties. So multiply your answer from step 3 by .875 (87.5%) to get the actual New Tax.

Instructions

- 1. "Total taxable value" includes the taxable value of all real property in the subdivision as indicated on the tax list most recently certified for collection and estimates of the taxable value of public utility personal property for the first year the levy will be collected as set forth on the worksheets prescribed in conjunction with this form. If the subdivision is located in more than one county, the home county auditor (where the greatest taxable value of the subdivision is located) shall obtain the assistance of the other county auditors to establish the total tax valuation of the subdivision.
- 2. For purposes of this certification, "subdivision" includes any agency, board, commission or other authority authorized to request a taxing authority to submit a tax levy on its behalf. See R.C. 5705.01(A) & (C).
- 3. "Levy type" includes the following: (1) additional, (2) renewal, (3) renewal with an increase, (4) renewal with a decrease, (5) replacement, (6) replacement with an increase and (7) replacement with a decrease levies.
- 4. In completing Lines 1 and 4 of this form, mills should be identified in whole numbers, i.e., 5 mills, rather than as a fraction of a dollar, i.e., \$0.005. This expression is consistent with the prior practice of identifying mills in whole numbers per \$1 of valuation.
- 5. "The county auditor's appraised value" means the true value in money of real property. R.C. 5705.01(P).
- 6. For any levy or portion of a levy, an estimate of the levy's annual collections, rounded to the nearest one thousand dollars, which shall be calculated assuming that the amount of the tax list of the taxing authority remains throughout the life of the levy the same as the amount of the tax list for the current year, and if this is not determined, the estimated amount submitted by the auditor to the county budget commission. R.C. 5705.03(B).
- 7. Please file this certificate with the subdivision as soon as possible, so the taxing authority can pass a resolution to proceed not later than 90 days before the election.

Notice is hereby given that, in pursuance of a certain Resolution adopted on the 17th Day of July, 2023 by the Village Council of Crooksville, in Perry County, Ohio, there will be submitted to the qualified electors of said Village, at the usual polling places in said Village, at the General Election in said Village, on Tuesday, November 7th, 2023, between the hours of 6:30 A.M. and 7:30 P.M., the question of levying **RENEWAL** taxes for Five (5) Years, commencing with the tax year 2024 (to be first collected in 2025), at the rate for each year of Four Tenths (0.4) Mills for each \$1 of taxable value, within the Village of Crooksville, Perry County, Ohio which amounts to Fourteen Dollars (\$14.00) for each \$100,000 of the County Auditor's appraised value, in excess of the rate authorized by Section 5705.02 of the Revised Code, i.e., in addition to the taxes levied within the Ten (10) Mill limitation authorized by law, for the purpose of operation of The Municipal Park and Swimming Pool, that the County Auditor estimates will collect \$9,000.00 annually, within said Village.

Those who vote in favor of making such levy will have written or printed on their ballots, "For the Tax Levy," and those who vote against such tax levy will have written or printed on their ballots, "Against the Tax Levy."
