## ORDINANCE NO. 2675

## ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE CARES ACT FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, the Village of Crooksville is in need of a separate fund within its accounting practices and systems that will be utilized as a fund for the specific purpose of accumulating monies received from the County in accordance with the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, 116 Public Law 136, (the CARES Act) signed into law by the President of the United States on March 27, 2020, and in accordance with the process for distributing funds enacted by the Ohio General Assembly under the "Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act" in Amended Substitute Senate Bill 310 of the 133<sup>rd</sup> General Assembly (S.B. 310); and

Whereas, in the interest of good fiscal practice and because the CARES Act funds are now available to the Village, it is necessary that the fund is created immediately.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED** by the Village Council of the Village of Crooksville, Perry County, State of Ohio, that:

- **Section 1**. A separate and specific fund is hereby established within the accounting practices and systems of the Village of Crooksville that will be utilized for the specific purpose of accumulating monies from the distribution of CARES Act funds, and for expending monies as it becomes necessary and as authorized by the Village Council to cover only those costs of the Village of Crooksville consistent with the requirements of Section 5001 of the CARES Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(d), and any applicable regulations and guidance. Said fund shall be known as the CARES ACT FUND.
- **Section 2**. Unless otherwise an emergency and approved in writing by the Mayor, the Village Administrator and Council, expenditures from said CARES ACT FUND shall be made only upon authorization of Council, and for payment of any and all expenditures permissible under the CARES Act.
- **Section 3.** This ordinance shall pass as an EMERGENCY and have immediate effect on its passage, in order that a fund is established at the earliest possible time for accumulation and record of the funds received as a result of the Village's anticipated receipt of CARES Act Funds in June 2020.
