**RESOLUTION TO REQUEST THE PERRY COUNTY ENGINEER TO RELEASE
AND UTILIZE THE VILLAGE OF CROOKSVILLE'S PERMISSIVE MOTOR
VEHICLE TAX FOR PAVING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

Whereas, the Village of Crooksville previously authorized paving for a certain Street Paving Project within the Village of Crooksville, the payment therefore to be made with permissive tax funds; and


Whereas, the paving has been performed for said Street Paving Project, the Invoice has been submitted, OWPC grant funds have been applied, and the balance owing by the Village of Crooksville is now due.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Village of Crooksville, Perry County, State of Ohio, that:

1. The County Engineer for Perry County, Ohio, immediately release and utilize Twenty-Four Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-Three and 83/100 Dollars (\$24,823.83) from the Village's Permissive Motor Vehicle Taxes, to be used for the Village of Crooksville's portion of Invoice for paving for the Village's Street Paving Program for 2020.
2. Emergency Clause: This resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary to permit the timely payment of invoices for services and paving performed. The reason for such necessity is to serve the general welfare of the Village by assisting the timely payment of invoices for services rendered to the Village of Crooksville. Therefore, this resolution shall go into immediate effect.
