RESOLUTION NO. 113-2022

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING MAYOR'S PARTNERSHIP FOR PROGRESS AS
LEAD TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE APPLICANT FOR THE
APPALACHIAN GRANT PROGRAM AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Appalachian Community Grant Program, created by House Bill 377, provides support to political subdivisions, educational institutions, port authorities, community improvement corporations, and nonprofits within the 32-county Ohio Appalachian region to undertake projects related to Infrastructure, Workforce, and Healthcare, and

WHEREAS, Mayor's Partnership for Progress is a nonprofit, nonpartisan group of Mayors and City Managers in 19 counties of Appalachia, and

WHEREAS, the Mayors' Partnership for Progress intends to make an application for technical assistance on behalf of the communities and the group's members for downtown revitalization, trails, tourism, healthcare and workforce, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Crooksville desires to authorize the Mayor's Partnership for Progress to apply, accept an award, implement, and/or submit materials or contract instruments required to request, receive and administer funding related to the Appalachian Community Grant Program technical assistance project and to expend funds to carry out the scope of work as specified in the executed contract documents in accordance with procurement policies and procedures.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Village of Crooksville, Perry County, State of Ohio, that:


1. The Village of Crooksville approves Mayor's Partnership for Progress as its lead technical assistance grant applicant for the Appalachian Community Grant Program.
2. That the Village of Crooksville will partner with Mayor's Partnership for Progress on the technical assistance application described above and authorizes Mayor's Partnership for Progress to apply on its behalf to the Appalachian Community Grant Program for the aforementioned technical assistance project.
3. Emergency Clause: This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the timely appointment and engagement of Mayor's Partnership for Progress as lead technical assistant in grant applications for the Appalachian Community Grant Program in order to ensure in the best interests and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Crooksville that all available opportunities for downtown revitalization, trails, tourism, healthcare and workforce are sought. Therefore, this ORDINANCE shall go into immediate effect upon its passage.
