RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF CROOKSVILLE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MORGAN COUNTY TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES (EMS) TO YORK TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the Village of Crooksville has Emergency Medical Services (EMS) physically situated in close proximity to York Township, Morgan County, and is therefore able and desires to provide York Township with Emergency Medical Services (EMS); and

WHEREAS, York Township lacks sufficient Emergency Medical Services (EMS) and therefore Morgan County desires the Village of Crooksville to provide York Township with Emergency Medical Services (EMS) for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of York Township; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code under Section 735.053 allows for the Village of Crooksville to enter into an agreement to provide Emergency Medical Services (EMS) to York Township; and

WHEREAS, upon the foregoing, the Village Council desires the Village of Crooksville, acting through its Mayor, Village Administrator and Fire Chief, to enter into an agreement with Morgan County to provide Emergency Medical Services (EMS) to York Township pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 735.053 and as otherwise allowed by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council of the Village of Crooksville, Perry County, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. In accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 735.053, the Village of Crooksville, acting through its Mayor, Village Administrator and Fire Chief, is hereby authorized and instructed to enter into an agreement with Morgan County to provide Emergency Medical

Services (EMS) to York Township.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is effective at the earliest date allowed by law.

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VILLAGE OF CROOKSVILLE/MORGAN COUNTY EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES (EMS) CONTRACT FOR YORK TOWNSHIP

This Agreement made by and between the Village of Crooksville, Perry County, State of Ohio, acting through its Mayor, Village Administrator and Fire Chief, hereinafter referred to as the "Village," and the County of Morgan, State of Ohio, acting through its Board of County Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as the "County" (Collectively, the "Parties"). Witnesseth:

WHEREAS, the Village has Emergency Medical Services (EMS) physically situated in close proximity to York Township, Morgan County, and is therefore able and desires to provide York Township with Emergency Medical Services (EMS); and

WHEREAS, York Township lacks sufficient Emergency Medical Services (EMS) and therefore the County desires the Village to provide York Township with Emergency Medical Services (EMS); and

WHEREAS, to that end, it has been resolved by the Village Council to enter into this Agreement between the Village and the County for Emergency Medical Services (EMS) for York Township pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 735.053 and as otherwise allowed by law; and

WHEREAS, to that end, it has been resolved by the Morgan County Board of County Commissioners to enter into this Agreement between the Village and the County for Emergency Medical Services (EMS) to York Township pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 307.05 and as otherwise allowed by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and the covenants and agreements herein set forth, the Parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. The Parties hereby incorporate the above statements into this Agreement.
- 2. The Village agrees to provide Emergency Medical Services (EMS) to the County's York

- 3. The Village and the County agree that said Emergency Medical Services (EMS) shall be provided under the direction and supervision of the Village's Fire Chief, hereinafter referred to as the "Village Fire Chief," who shall be in charge of the overall operation of providing Emergency Medical Services (EMS) to York Township and who shall be appointed by and be under the direction of the Village Mayor and Council. The Village Fire Chief shall be responsible to see that all personnel are trained in accordance with State regulations applicable to Emergency Medical Services (EMS) when obtaining their EMS certification, including any refresher training required to maintain present status. Cost of EMS certification training, refresher training, including special training, which shall include only the costs of instructor's fees, manual, workbooks, and special equipment needed for said training, and registration fees for said training, shall be paid by the Village in accordance with its personnel rules. The Village further agrees to provide and maintain such equipment as may be deemed necessary for the Village's proper operation of said Emergency Medical Services (EMS), the cost of which shall be covered by the Village, within the County's per run payment for said service.
- 4. The County promises and agrees to pay to the Village for said Emergency Medical Services (EMS) provided for the duration of this Agreement the sum of One Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$100.00) per Emergency Medical Services Run ("EMS Run") within York Township, Morgan County, Ohio. The Village will provide the County an invoice every six (6) months, listing the EMS Runs made by date, time and address, together with the total amount due for the EMS Runs made within that six-month period. The County shall make payment to the Village within

thirty (30) days of each invoice.

- 5. The Village and the County agree to be bound by the jurisdictional boundaries as set forth in the "York Township" tax map, which is currently on file at the Morgan County Engineer's Office, as amended from time to time, the current version of which is attached hereto and labeled as Exhibit "A" and which is fully incorporated by reference.
- 6. The Parties agree to open negotiations to change, amend, and/or supplement this Agreement every two (2) years, in advance of the date of this Agreement's expiration.
- 7. The Parties agree to pass all appropriate resolutions and/or ordinances to do all things necessary and proper to authorize and/or ratify this Agreement and to carry out the terms of this Agreement.

The undersigned, Auditor of Morgan County, Ohio hereby certifies that funds are available, or in the process of collection, sufficient to meet the requirements of this Agreement for the County.
