Council Workshop Meeting

June 8, 2026

Mayor Mohler calls the meeting to order with the following council members present; Mr. Hampton, Mr. Locke, Mr. Loomis, Mr. Redfern, Ms. Smith, and Ms. McKinney. Lacey Tumlin and Courtney Edwards were also present.

First up on the agenda, Mrs. Tumblin stated that we had an individual that drove through the wall that is at the Village Park entrance. She then drove across the grass and ended up with her vehicle stuck in the pond. Mrs. Tumblin is getting a quote from Randy Willet to have the wall replaced. It is beyond repair. Chief Alexander stated that everything is done on his end and can be cleaned up if they want to try and get it done before the Community Celebration at the end of the month.

Next up, Mrs. Tumblin stated that she and Mrs. Edwards will be attending a meeting in Grove City all day tomorrow. It is the RCAP Utility and will be to discuss the water/sewer rates and different expenses.

Mayor Mohler announced that the Community Celebration is scheduled for Saturday, June 27th. This year, changes have been made to the fireworks display location. The fireworks will now be launched from within the old football field, providing a safe and centralized viewing experience for attendees. In addition, the size of the firework shells has increased from 2 inches to 4 inches, which is the maximum size permitted. This location change will allow for a larger and more impressive fireworks display for the community to enjoy. In the event of inclement weather, the rain date has been scheduled for Sunday, June 28th.

Chief Newlon spoke about the firetruck that they are interested in purchasing. They submitted a list of items that they are requesting to be fixed prior to purchasing. When he gets a response, he will keep Council up to date.
