**RESOLUTION NO. 32-2026**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A GAS CHOICE CUSTOMER CONTRACT WITH SYMMETRY ENERGY SOLUTIONS, LLC, FOR THE VILLAGE'S GAS FACILITIES ACCOUNTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, Aspen Energy Corporation is an entity certified by the Ohio Public Utilities Commission to provide competitive retail Gas Aggregate Power Broker Services within the State of Ohio; and

**WHEREAS**, Aspen Energy Corporation presented the Village of Crooksville with an opportunity to secure its Gas supply needs from Symmetry Energy Solutions, LLC, at a significant savings over that by which the Village has previously secured its Gas supply needs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Crooksville requires Gas supply at each of its various facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Village of Crooksville has determined it appropriate and in the best interests of fiscal responsibility and the general welfare of the Village to authorize the Village Administrator to enter into a Gas Choice Customer Contract for the Village's facilities for a forty-eight (48) month period commencing March 24, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Village of Crooksville has deemed it necessary to pass this Resolution as an emergency measure so as to allow sufficient time to commence its Gas supply savings at the earliest possible supply period.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Village Council of the Village of Crooksville, Perry County, State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION 1.** Lacey Tumblin, Village Administrator, is hereby authorized to enter into a Gas Choice Customer Contract for Gas energy for each of the Village's facilities, for a forty-eight (48) month period commencing March 24, 2026, in accordance with the terms of that certain Gas Choice Customer Contract brokered by Symmetry Energy Solution, LLC, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

**SECTION 2.** This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure and shall become effective upon passage, in order to allow sufficient time to commence significant Gas supply savings for the Village's facilities at the earliest possible supply period, in the best interests and general welfare of the Village of Crooksville.


